As a result of the CTS Groups Phase I and Phase II projects, the Palmyra R-I School District has been awarded the US Environmental Protection Agency coveted Energy Star Award for both the High School and Elementary Schools for energy efficiency and environmental responsibility.

"We started looking at our facility needs about 3 years ago. After prioritizing our needs we talked to architectural firms and to energy performance companies. Background

As part of the Phase I project, CTS developed a master plan for the District in 2006 which set the guidelines for District-wide improvements. CTS assembled facility information to promote the bond issue to the community in the spring of 2007. The April bond issue passed with a high margin and the board then awarded the contract to CTS.

Phase I work at the High School (full renovation of the facility) was completed during the short summer break. Following the success of Phase I the District immediately proceeded with Phase II at the Elementary School with the remodeling of the existing space plus construction of a 14,834 sq. ft. addition.

The Phase II project at the Elementary School included:

- / Complete design and construction of a new gymnasium, classrooms, restroom and kitchen space.
- Remodel of the existing kitchen and office space over the 2008 summer vacation in time for fall classes.
- The District is now able to have a much more efficient class schedule and better use of the facilities.
